5. Update on Space Symposium and PR SpacePort – 10 mins

We talked briefly about the proposed Spaceport and the delegation from Puerto Rico that traveled to the Space Symposium. Dr Gilberto Guavara from the Science Trust noted that there are already payload launches with local universities, namely UPR RP with 14+ launches with NASA and the Inter Bayamon with 1 launch. Because we did not have time for a comprehensive review we'll do a full presentation at our next meeting on Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup>.

6. Other Announcements – 5 mins

Puerto Rico is launching a new '21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce Initiative'. I've added the link above. This initiative will invest \$50 million over the next 10 years with a goal of creating a workforce of 50,000 technology qualified individuals on the Island.
